¹These program costs are charged to the U-bill and will be due in full on August 20, 2011.

²Housing costs are charged to the Rome Program in euros and will appear on the U-bill as an amount converted to dollars based on the exchange rate at the time of billing, which is currently estimated to occur in late July 2011. Housing costs could be higher or lower than what is stated here. Sometimes fluctuating exchange rates require us to make a second smaller charge to the U-bill to accurately reflect the total amount charged to the program.

³The escrow is retained by the college until the cost of utilities (electricity, gas, telephone, and Internet) is determined for each apartment after the semester. The utilities cost in euros will be equally shared by all students in an apartment, converted to dollars based on the exchange rate at the time of billing, and deducted from the escrow. The balance will be refunded to the U-bill. All students are charged a 30 euro cleaning fee. If a student causes damages to the apartment or to the studio, the cost will be deducted from the escrow of the responsible student. If no one takes responsibility for apartment damages, all students in that apartment will be charged equally. If no one takes responsibility for studio damages, all students will be charged equally. If the total exceeds \$800, the additional cost will appear on the U-bill as a separate charge.

⁴*Mandatory Italian health insurance:* students are required by Italian law to purchase this upon arrival in Italy. It is for emergencies only and does not take the place of an American insurance policy. *Permit of Stay:* required by Italian law for students staying more than 90 days. Students must apply online with a credit card for these items once they have received their study visa. The credit card will be charged after the student arrives in Rome. Housing office staff in Rome will help students to obtain their insurance and permit of stay. *Apartment key deposit:* 20 euros payable in cash (exact change only) upon check-in at housing office.

This budget is an initial projection of the costs for the Rome Program. This estimated budget was made available on 1/10/11. Please keep in mind that these numbers are projections and may be subject to change. Furthermore, the amounts given represent base estimates only and may vary among individual students depending on spending habits. Nevertheless, the amounts should provide a reasonably accurate basis for initial financial planning.

Fall 2011 – Withdrawal Penalties – All Students

The application deadline for the fall 2011 program is March 2, 2011. All students who are accepted to participate must either confirm or reject their offer in the ISUAbroad online application system no later than March 7, 2011. Those students who confirm their offer are officially part of the program and will be responsible for the penalties outlined below only if withdrawal occurs. The withdrawal penalty will be applied to the U-bill and will be due in full on August 20, 2011. The participant is also responsible for all program payments the college is obligated to make on his or her behalf.

Date	Withdrawal Penalty
After confirming offer in ISUAbroad and before March 23, 2011:	\$200.00
On or after March 23, 2011 and before June 29, 2011:	50% of program fee (\$1,650)
On or after June 29, 2011:	Full program fee (\$3,300)
